## 2015 Study Group Schedule

### *The Shiloh Campaign*

The topics of the study group's monthly presentations may shift as needed or be expanded upon at the decision of that month's presenter. Announcements of the monthly meeting places (usually at the presenter or another study group member's home) will be made at the regular Rocky Mountain Civil War Round Table meetings on the second Thursday of each month.

Study group meetings will take place on the *third Thursday* of each month unless otherwise specified. Meeting reminders and maps of the location usually will be sent by email to anyone on the group's mailing list.

**February 19** – Opening Movements of the Armies.

**March 19** – Shiloh Personalities. Several members of the group will present short (10 minutes or so) vignettes of some of the major Union and Confederate figures involved with the campaign.

**April 23** – *For this month only, the study group meeting will take place on the fourth Thursday in April.*

The Battle of Shiloh begins. Events up to noon of the first day, April 6, 1862.

**May 21** – The Hornet's Nest, the Peach Orchard, Bloody Pond – noon to 5 p. m.

**June 18** – Conclusion of the first day's events. The arrival of Lew Wallace – 5 p. m. to midnight.

**July 16** – Day 2. The Confederate reversal of fortunes, Forrest at Fallen Timbers.

**August 20** – The Battles of Iuka and Corinth.

**September 17** – Wrap-up and field trip planning. Field trips usually take place in late September or early October. Actual trip dates will be determined later.
